Happy New Year and best wishes for 2013! I hope you spent a nice Christmas break.

As you might remember, the Romanian law transposing the Data Retention Directive stipulates that the obligation for providers of electronic communication services and providers of public electronic communications networks to retain traffic and location data for a period of six months (Article 3(1) and (2)) only enters into force six months after the entry into force of the law (Article 25(3)). As the Romanian law had entered into force on 21 June 2012, I suppose the obligation to retain traffic and location data entered into force on 21 December 2012.

As discussed previously, could you please confirm this in an email? I would need this for my file.
